 Scholarship applicants must be a currently enrolled 8th grade student at a school in Westminster Public Schools in Colorado. One \$1000 scholarship will be awarded in the 2021/2022 academic year. The scholarship will be held in the recipient's name by the Randy E Roybal Foundation, Inc. until July 31 at 11:59 p.m. in the second year following anticipated high school graduation date entered into this application. Scholarship funds not utilized by this date will be forfeited by the student. Extensions will not be permitted. Scholarship funds may be used towards tuition and fees for a university, college or trade school of the recipient's choice. Funds will be paid in the student's name directly to the receiving institution.
