

# WPS Competency Tracker

## What is the WPS competency tracker?

The competency tracker in Westminster Public Schools (WPS) is a new, easy-to-understand form to help students and families track academic progress over the course of the school year and determine progress to on-time graduation.

## How does it work?

Students will document their current progress across all subject areas and performance levels at the start of the school year. The competency tracker will be updated throughout the school year as students complete performance levels. Then a full update will be provided near the end of the school year to celebrate the student's growth.

## What is the benefit?

The competency tracker will help students (and their families) set goals on a path toward on-time graduation.

## Does the competency tracker replace Empower?

No, the competency tracker is a paper document used in addition to the information in the online Empower tool to support goal setting.

## Is it complicated?

Not at all. It is very simple because students already understand that in a Competency Based System (CBS) they need to show that they fully understand the subject before moving on to the next level. The competency tracker is customized for elementary (primary and intermediate), middle school and high school students.

## How will students learn to use the competency tracker?

All students will receive a competency tracker with step-by-step instructions during the first weeks of school.
