## An Introduction for Students and Guardians

Students and guardians will see a very similar homepage when they log into Empower. The one difference is that guardians will be able to choose to view the homepages of any one of their children after they log in.

Each class or group will have a separate section on the homepage. Clicking the “+” icon will open a class or group so students can view work, scores, and progress in that class.

### Hiding Classes & Groups

If there are classes or groups that teachers have said will not be used in Empower, students or guardians are able to hide them from view. Click the **Filter** button and check or uncheck the classes to hide or unhide them.

### Pacing & Standards

This section of a class will show how well a student is progressing in a class. There are two components, Pacing and the Overall Standard Scores

**Pacing:** Students who are “Ahead of Pace” or “On Pace” are expected to successfully finish their class by the end of the year. Students who are “Behind Pace” should talk with their teacher to figure out what needs to be done to be back on pace.

**Standard Scores:** Clicking this grey bubble will open a window that shows all of the standards a student is expected to become proficient on. They should have a score 3.0 or better in all standards to finish a class.

### Activities & Quizzes

The activities and quizzes teachers create will appear in one of these sections above. Students can click on them to begin working or to turn in work to be scored.

**Next Up:** These are the activities that students should focus on completing next.

**Class Activities:** Teachers may place some additional activities here to work on. These are often in addition to the normal class work.

**Missing Activities:** If a teacher has marked anything as missing, it will appear here. This helps students find and complete all your missing work!

### Class Log

The Class Log is where students can find the scores and messages for activities and quizzes that teachers have scored. When students have something new to see, a red notification will appear. Clicking on this icon will show just the new scores and messages. If you want to see all of the scores, click the **View all** button in this popup window.
