

In Empower, students are able to submit work directly to their teachers online. Students can submit simple text responses, links to webpages, uploaded files, drawings, and documents directly from their Google Drive. Not all work will be expected to be completed online, so make sure you understand your teachers' expectations!

To access an activity, click on the activity's icon

Each activity has four tabs...

**Goals**  
This tab gives you a general description of the assignment as well as an explanation of the standards that are being worked on in this activity.

**Action**  
This is where you see the steps, or directions for the activity. Make sure you read all of the steps!

In this tab, you can also write text, draw, upload documents, add links, and share Google Documents with your teachers.

If you click "Save and Turn In", your teacher will be alerted right away that you submitted work.

**My Locker**  
Your digital locker is where you can see all the work you have saved or attached to this assignment. If you clicked "Save" for your work in the Action tab, now you need to click the circle next to the file you want to turn in. A check mark in a green circle means your teacher is notified that your work is ready to score. If you don't "turn in your work" by check the circle, your teacher won't know you are finished!

**Feedback**  
Do you have a question or feedback for your teacher? This tab will let you start a private discussion between you and your teacher.

You could use this to ask for additional help, reflect on how you felt you did, or just let them know how you felt about the assignment.
