SCHOOL AND COMMUNITY

Westminster is a northwestern suburb of Denver with a population of 95,000. Westminster High School is one of two high schools in Westminster Public Schools. It is a four year, comprehensive high school with an International Baccalaureate Programme. Student enrollment is approximately 2500 students in grades 9-12.

CREDITS AND GRADUATION REQUIREMENTS

All classes are either a semester in length (.5 credits) or a year in length (1 credit). A total of 22 credits is required to graduate.

Schedule is an alternating block. There are 7 periods which meet for 53 minutes on Monday, Tuesday and Friday. Classes alternate on Wednesday and Thursday for 85 minutes. There are 18 weeks in a semester; 36 weeks in the school year. Summer school classes are offered through a partnership with the Hidden Lake High School.

COMPUTATION OF G.P.A.

GPA is a computation on a 4-point scale. AP & IB classes are weighted classes and are allowed an additional factor after normal GPA is computed. All courses except student assistant, off-campus courses and work experience/OJT are computed into GPA.

Weighting System

4.0 = 4 points + .60 for AP/IB
3.5 = 3.5 points + .525 for AP/IB
3.0 = 3 points + .45 for AP/IB
2.0 = 2 points + .30 for AP/IB
