

After Hours Credit Recovery

Overview

Thank you for your interest in After-Hours at Hidden Lake, a part of Westminster Virtual Academy. We are a unique program, offering highly personalized on-line learning remediation and hands-on teaching to small groups of students. We pride ourselves on providing a supportive, nurturing, enriching, comfortable and safe school environment, where you can work to achieve your academic goals.

After-Hours provides an extended learning opportunity beyond the traditional school day for students who are currently enrolled at Westminster High School. Evening courses meet Monday, Tuesday, Thursday, and Friday from 2:30-4:10 PM, during the school year. Students may also work from home or their home school at any time. Students may earn or be granted Off-site status through Hidden Lake Administration. We will work with your home school to understand what learning has occurred to date.

Enrollment

Enrollment at After-Hours is on a first come, first served basis until capacity is reached. Those who are placed on a waiting list will be contacted when an opening becomes available. Enrollment can only be completed through the Hidden Lake High School Main Office. Your Counseling Office may assist you in completing the form. **Once completed, bring the form and payment to Hidden Lake High School's Main Office between 3-4pm.**

Cost

Cost is \$120 for the first course; \$100 for each consecutive course paid in full prior to beginning the course. Accepted forms of payment are credit/debit card, check or cash paid at the Hidden Lake High School Main Office.

Attendance Requirements

- Attendance is mandatory for ALL students. Students may earn the opportunity to work off-site through demonstrated work completion or HLHS administrative approval
- The HLHS administration will grant an excused absence to a student with a doctor's note, court papers or prior approval by the HLHS administration
- If a student is more than 30 minutes late or leaves early, he/she will be counted absent for that day
- Accumulating 5 or more absences will subject the course for termination until an attendance plan is finalized.

Academic Requirements

- A grade of 80% or higher is required on each submission, quiz/or assessment
- Completion of all activities is required
- Notebook with notes on each course's lessons and submission may be requested to receive resets
- Reflective Essay, or cumulative project may be required for completion
- Completion dates without additional costs charged: December 14, 2018
